The Chase for \$100,000 Kicks off on the St. Johns River for the Crappie Masters Tournament

DeLand, FL – Anglers for the Bass Pro Shops[®] Crappie Masters fishing tournament have a new big prize for the overall winning team: \$100,000. Fishing times are set from 7:00am-3:30pm. The official weigh-ins are scheduled at the Ed Stone Park at 4:30pm, located along the St. Johns River adjacent to S.R. 44 before the Whitehair Bridge.

In addition, a seminar and registration is set for Thursday, January 26 at the Sanborn Activity and Event Center in DeLand. Registration is from 5:00-6:30 pm with the rules meeting beginning at 6:30 pm.

A free Kids' Rodeo Fishing Contest will be held on Saturday, January 28 at Highland Park Fish Camp, with registration from 8:00-9:00 am; and fishing from 9:00-10:30. This youth tournament allows participants to have fun, fish for prizes and learn about the delights of the sport of fishing. Each child goes home a winner, as every participant will receive prizes and gifts from tournament sponsors.
